

School Rules

A school is a small version of a whole society. For it to function well and be a pleasant place to be in, all people present in our school have to treat each other with respect and follow certain rules. Students, teachers and additional staff at Torsbergsgymnasiet have established a number of rules:

At Torsbergsgymnasiet the following rules apply:

- Everyone present in school shall treat each other with respect
- We respect those with allergies; no strong scents to be used at school
- No nuts, peanuts or almonds are allowed on the premises
- We all act in a way so that our school can be proud of us
- Tobacco is not allowed during the school day
- Everybody takes good care of the school facilities and equipment
- Electronic equipment may only be used in class if it doesn't cause disturbance. The teacher makes the decision whether it should be used
- Everyone present in school contributes to a good work environment by keeping the level of sound down within the whole school
- Everyone respects starting as well as ending times for meetings and lessons
- Everyone follows the school's policy documents (see school web page). Alcohol and other drugs are not allowed, see the drug policy.
- Symbols with a racist or Nazi message, which are clearly against the fundamental values of the school curriculum, are not allowed to be worn, or in any way made visible, within the school
- Everyone is aware that malpractice and plagiarism are not allowed (see separate Policy against Malpractice)
- Visitors need a permit from the Head of School
